- Squealing or grinding noise from brakes.
- Car pulls from one side to the other.
- Brakes require pumping to stop.
- Spongy feel when pressing brake pedal.

A quick inspection of your brake pads can determine that they are worn and are in need of immediate replacement. While some car owners are comfortable with changing their own brake pads, most require the expertise of a certified mechanic or auto garage. Your car's braking system is not an area for tinkering. If you do take your car in for an inspection, it doesn't hurt to ask your mechanic for a complete check of your braking system. Most shops will perform this service anyway to ensure your safety on the road.
