The Evolution of **Car Safety...**

Car safety technology and laws have continuously improved over the years, making it safer for drivers, passengers, and even pedestrians. Here is a look at just a few of the major milestones from the early 1900s to present.



1934 - General Motors performs the first crash test.

1949 - The Chrysler Crown Imperial is the first car to include standard disc brakes.



1959 - Volvo introduces the first 3-point seat belt as standard equipment.



1964 - Volvo introduces the first rear-facing child safety seat.

1966 - The U.S. Department of Transportation and the National Transportation Safety Board are founded.

1969 - Front headrests become mandatory to prevent whiplash.

1970 - Ford offers a rear-wheel Anti-Lock Brake system.

1974 - General Motors offers optional driver and passenger airbags.



1979 - The NHTSA begins crash-testing and publishing results.



1984 - New York passes the first seat-belt law.

1986 - Third brake lights become standard.



1994 - Crash-tests become mandatory for all vehicles.

1995 - All states (except New Hampshire) require that all passengers wear safety belts. Adults 18 and older in New Hampshire are not required to wear a safety belt.

2003 - The IIHS begins side impact crash-testing.

2004 - The NHTSA establishes new rollover risk tests for new cars and SUVs.

2009 - Intelligent Anti-Skid systems are introduced.

Examples of more recent technologies include backup cameras, blind-spot detectors, lane drifting alerts, collision alerts, and dual-stage airbags.

A fresh coat of wax can help protect your car from road dirt and grime all year long. Make sure you coat your headlights and keep them clean too. Your night-time visibility will be greatly improved!
