Neither can we, but here is some advice on how to clean insects from your car and prevent potential damage to your paint's finish.



1. Remove bugs and clean your car regularly to prevent hardening of the bug and permanent staining.
2. Select and use a bug remover product. Follow directions and allow the product to soak in and then wipe away with a sponge or microfiber towel. Repeat is necessary to remove all the residue.
3. Follow up by washing your car and thoroughly cleaning those areas.
4. Apply a good wax to your car. This will make future cleanings much easier.


### **Summer car care check list!**

Before hitting the road this summer, you can take several simple precautions to keep your car operating properly and your family safe. Extreme heat and


